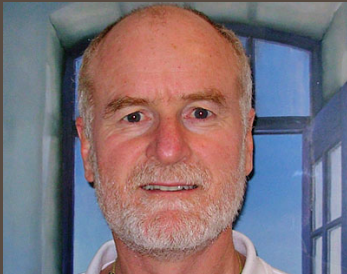




TRAINING IN NST

Background History of NST: In 1991 practicing Applied Physiologist, Michael J. Nixon-Livy from Australia recognized the urgent need for much of the unique later work of Tom Bowen to be organized into a practical, usable and teachable system. This truly integrated and effective system was given the name Neurostructural Integration Technique (NST) being deemed representative of the later advanced style of Tom Bowen's work. Therefore, NST is clearly and emphatically in a class of its own.

The main aim of NST is to reintegrate the body-mind complex as a whole. It is often called contextual healing, consequently regarding illnesses as symptoms of imbalance.
